

POWER OF ATTORNEY

The undersigned

hereinafter called the Principal(s), hereby gives full power and authority, with right of substitution to

The Attorney is authorized to represent the Principal(s) in the above matter(s) and to take all necessary actions in his/her/their name(s). In particular, the Attorney is authorized to institute legal proceedings, to enter into a settlement or an arbitration agreement, and to declare a waiver or abandonment. The Attorney undertakes to protect the interests of the Principal(s) to the best of his knowledge and in compliance with the law; he promises loyalty and confidentiality.

The Principal(s) undertake(s) to indemnify the Attorney for all costs and fees in accordance with the provisions of the Statute on Attorneys and the Regulation on Costs for Legal Representation and Assistance. Special agreements remain reserved. The Principal(s) undertake(s) to pay the Attorney, upon request, an appropriate advance of fees and if necessary to supplement it.

Any dispute between the Principal(s) and the Attorney shall be decided by the Court having jurisdiction at the Attorney's place of business, unless the law provides for an exclusive forum. The provisions on jurisdiction of the Chamber of Attorneys of the Canton of Berne remain reserved.

A duplicate of this Power of Attorney is available to the Principal(s). The Principal(s) may revoke this Power of Attorney at any time.
